Who We Are

PROGRAMS & SERVICES

INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT PROGRAM

Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) which is a 12 to 16 week treatment program, with a minimum of 10 hours per week. Group sessions meet three times a week for 3 hours. Individual counseling is one hour a week. With gender specific treatments and services.

THERAPEUTIC LIVING PROGRAM

Therapeutic Living Program offers a structured, supportive, clean and sober living environment where women in treatment, or recently clinically discharged, can concentrate on their recovery. Rehabilitative life skills groups and case management services are provided to help participants learn to lead healthy, productive lives and develop strong basis of sober living and support in the community

BABY S.A.F.E.

Baby S.A.F.E. is an early intervention and outreach program, for pregnant women who are at risk for substance abuse. Support group atmosphere that focuses on parenting education, child development, nutrition, domestic violence issues, family planning, STD and other health care education.
