

OUR MISSION

The mission of Malama Family Recovery Center is to address the well being of the women and children of Maui County and Hawaii by encouraging wholesome living habits, preventing or minimizing the use of harmful substances, and providing family centered treatment for drug and alcohol abuse/addiction.

Our outreach and treatment programs are designed to assist participants, including children, adults and their families to achieve their maximum potential for self-sufficiency through a holistic approach that encourages psychological, social, physical and spiritual health and development.



OUTPATIENT PROGRAM

The Outpatient Program is an 8 to 10 week treatment program. Group sessions meet two times a week for 2 hours. Individual counseling is one hour a week, 1-4 per month

Gender Specific services and treatment offered include:

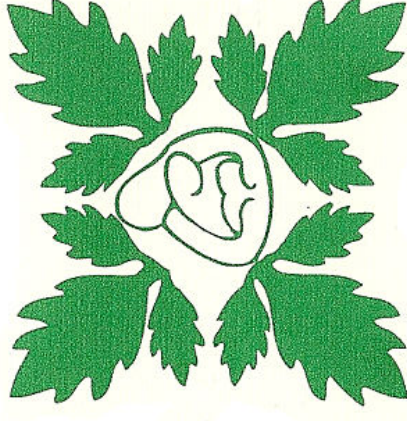
- ❖ Assessment for abuse/addiction level of care

INTAKE CRITERIA

Any woman whose life has been affected by substance abuse (tobacco, alcohol, drugs) or who is at risk for use. Emphasis is on pregnant women and women with children.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Certain health plans are accepted, as well as self-pay. Medically uninsured are eligible for services.



AFTER CARE TREATMENT

Support meeting one hour per week. Outpatient Program (OP.) Individual sessions and case management are also available.

THERAPEUTIC LIVING PROGRAM

(Available on Maui only)

The Therapeutic Living Program offers a structured, supportive, clean and sober living environment where women in treatment, or recently clinically discharged, can concentrate on their recovery. Each woman may have one child, under the age of three (3), living on the premises with them. Twenty-four hour/seven days a week staffing provides safety, and monitors adherence to program guidelines.

Rehabilitative life skills groups and case management services are provided to help participants learn to lead healthy, productive lives and develop a strong basis of sober living and support in the community.
